張美萍女士

張女士少年時在港隨朱麗雲女士學習細琴,後移民美 國在羅斯福大學隨名師 Saul Dorfman繼續學琴。中學畢業後 入 北 園 大 學 主 修 音 樂 教 育 及 細 琴 , 副 修 管 風 琴 及 指 揮 , 獲 音樂教育學十。 隋後考獲獎學金進入而北大學主修細琴, 跟隋名師並室樂演奏家 Gui Mombaerts 習琴, Guv Duck worth (MFNC 編琴科主席)學習編琴教授法,專門天才兒 童、小組教授法。一年後獲得音樂碩士並同時被激爲 Mu Phi Fpsilon及 Pi Kappa Lamda兩美國榮譽音樂協會會員, 繼而被激留校細琴系初中組任教五年,期間在美國芝城教 會担任風琴師及詩班指揮十多年,又曾參加名指揮家Robert Shaw 及 Margaret Hillis 主辦的合唱指揮研習班,鋼琴家 Victor Babin的大師班。伴奏家 Gerald Moore及聲樂家 Lotte Lehman 合辦的伴奏大師班。

深感神所賜音樂恩賜應專心從事聖樂工作。於是隨夫 婿張慕皚博士往西南浸會神學院深造。選修了一年的聖樂 博士課程。(跟隋 Robert Burton 研習深造指揮法及選修管 風琴)在院期間,兼任和聲學、樂理及鋼琴科助教,及專 任聖樂院的聲樂科伴奏。隨後與夫婿往加拿大神學院事奉 ,任教聖樂科,同時繼續在教會詩班任指揮及其他事奉。

1980年,回港事奉,現任九龍城浸信會聖樂主任及指 揮,建道神學院教會音樂科講師。曾在港九教會機構担任 聖樂講座,司琴、領詩、指揮及詩班等訓練班講師。現任 香港聖樂學院董事、世界華人聖樂促進會香港區理事,白 1984 年 爲 欣 樂 詠 團 指 揮 。

北角简理兒童合唱團

北角衞理兒童合唱團是由北角衞理堂主辦,梁林開牧師任團牧,於一九八三年七月成立,目的是培養兒童有良好的歌唱基礎,正確的發聲法,並對音樂有基本的認識,接受資理,並爲敎會詩班和聖樂工作培養接班人,聖樂界和敎育界知名人仕如黃永熙博士,凌金園女士,葉志明先生,陳之霞女士,楊伯倫先生,陸趙鈞鴻校長,劉國強校長,張志賢校長,毛昭宇義務敎士及吳伯齡太平紳士等皆爲該團之顧問,給予多方面的指導和支持,使該團三年來漸漸地成長。

目前該團有團員 180人左右,年齡由五歲至十四歲,分設合唱團,芭蕾舞班及鋼琴班,按程度分初、中、高級訓練,除每週之經常性訓練外,亦常有參加社團活動,並應各宗教團體之邀請,前往演唱,會參加循道衞理「百週年聖樂獻唱會」,「世界循道衞理宗婦女日」,香港讀經會主辦之「兒童經文頌唱會」,「兒童詩班講座」,「85年青年聖歌之夜」,世界宣明會主辦「愛的獻禮」等會中演出,深獲讚賞,又在教會的復活節、聖誕節,聖樂佈道會中獻詩,藉此使團員們與家長們多有機會接觸教會、聆聽福音。

為增加團員的演出經驗,與海外的兒童合唱團有機會互相交流,觀摩、學習。特於今年七月組團赴台灣巡廻演出五場,內容包括聖詩,古典歌曲及民歌等,深獲當地教會及各界人士之歡迎和讚賞。

在邁入第四年中,我們深感及早培養兒童音樂人才和基督化人格的重要性,亦盼望藉着兒童將福音傳給家長們,讓更多的人得到快樂,也為教會培訓良好的聖樂工作人才,使教會聖工更得發展,榮神益人。

樊道霞女士為柴灣浸信會會友,現在浸信會神學院修讀宗教教育學系課程。1978年隨筲箕灣浸信會詩班赴澳門及星馬泰作聖樂佈道。亦曾經隨香港兒童合唱團往澳洲(1984年)及加拿大(1986年)巡廻演出,曾為該團手鈴隊指揮。自1983年迄今為北角衛理堂兒童合唱團指揮,於本年與該團出國組往台灣巡廻佈道演出,甚獲當地教會欣賞。

節目簡介

於樂詠團以柴可夫斯基的L天使之歌 N開始這十週年音樂會,表達出詠團的目的乃願如歌詞所說:L像一隊榮耀的天軍頌唱讚美神 N。整個音樂會所採用聖樂作品的主題都是述說神的屬性:犠牲的愛、公義、信實、思慈、尊貴、權能、聖潔及智慧等。

第一組接着的兩首分別是美國及蘇格蘭民 歌改編的無伴奏曲。前者簡單親切帶出在主懷 中的安祥及溫暖。後者和聲較空洞,採用的平 行五度尤能帶出基督受苦的景像。

第二組選自巴哈的B小調彌撒曲及孟德爾 選的以利亞神曲中的合唱曲。巴哈妙絕的對亞 手法在此將四或五聲部編織成有令人驚驚趣的 度的合唱,分別將救主降世及受苦的經歷活的 在眼前。孟德爾遜所採用的表達方式不必 的注重内心形像之表達;而是用優美的光 题著的强弱,雄厚的音色等浪漫樂派色彩的感 神各種不同屬性描寫到淋漓畫緻。最後的感謝神各種不同屬性描寫, 神學是氣勢磅礴的讓詠團藉一曲表達對神十年來的保守作出感恩。

黃楨茂曲及陳明勳詞的「智慧之歌」是一九 七四年的作品。黃教授採用兒童與成人合唱去 描寫人得智慧的途徑。詩詞思想明確配以雄壯 激昂的旋律與和聲,實為一中國聖樂佳作。

第四組的三首歌是加拿大聖經學院一位作

曲及鋼琴教授David MeIntyre 為該校差傳年會所寫。身為鋼琴家,他特為此作品譜以雙鋼琴伴奏將鋼琴的華彩音色及技巧造詣發揮畫至。合唱部份並不因此遜色,以强烈且明快的節奏,廣闊的音域,近代音樂的合唱和聲,將歷代志上十六章及馬太十六章十八節的訊息帶出東用平靜但扣人心弦的對照將十架的挑戰演繹出來,叫聽者不得不受感向主作出回應。

從這回應帶進一連四個不同時代及方式的 禱告。第一首「我救贖主」是法國十九世紀以藝 術歌曲見稱的科彌的作品。此曲旋律極其優美 。原著以弦樂及低音號伴奏。現由法國號及鋼 琴亦能將這豐滿的音色彈奏出來。主禱文是熟 識的Malotte 版本。將聽者帶進到一個崇拜的經 歷中。隨後的兩首祝福歌皆出自近代最受 戴的藥數學作家John Rutter。他清新簡複的 和聲,感人的旋律使歌者不難表達出神祝福的 平安,喜樂及永恆。

最後的一組是訊息帶挑戰性的詩歌。「我 是」將耶穌在聖經中不同的地方所說的「我是」 列攀出來。繼續的一首「耶穌是答案」是簡單的 福音詩歌,重申主的信實。兩首歌都可以向聽 者介紹耶穌基督是誰。音樂會在Rutter的「大 地好風光」一曲之下結束,呼召聽衆與歌者一 同向神發出歡樂感恩的讚美。

PROGRAMME NOTES

To open the concert with Tschaikowsky's "Chendim Song" is to acknowledge the purpose and direction of the Innomine Chorale at her Tenth Anniversary Concert. In the last decade, Innomine Chorale has tried to be "like a glorious choir of angels bringing praises to our heav'nly father." We ask that the audience join the chorale in bringing tribute to the Lord through the performance of sacred literature of various styles and periods. The theme of the programme reveals the many attributes of God: His sacrificial love, righteousness, faithfulness, goodness, majesty, strength, holiness and wisdom.

The other two selections in the first group are folk hymns of early American and Scottish origins respectively. "I Will Arise" is a simple arrangement of the folk melody however it paints the picture of the serenity one has in the arms of Jesus. "I See His Blood upon the Rose", the last of the a capella group, is a beautiful setting of a poem by Joseph Plunkett. It was written in the 1930's thus having a touch of the contemporary harmonic progression with parallel fifths between the tenor and bass parts which adds to the austere character of the text of Passion nature.

The second group begins with two well loved selections from Bach's B Minor Mass. Et Incarnatus Est is a five part chorus with intricately woven counterpoint over a pedal point. "Crucifixus" was written on a chaconne, originally for his Cantata 12. It makes use of a descending chromatic motif in the bass line (recurring 13 times). The rich harmony constructed on four independent vocal lines provide a sense of awe in grief depicting the crucifixion. The last chaconne brings the piece to a G Major cadence by use of a German Sixth signaling the triumph of our Lord's resurrection.

The three choruses from Mendelssohn's Elijah are selected to portray God's faithfulness (He that Shall Endure to the End), His graciousness, compassion and righteousness (Blessed are the Men who Fear Him). Lastly "Thanks be to God" summarizes the strength and goodness of God as He laveth the thirsty land. In the similar way the Chorale wants to pay trubite to God thanking Him for His guidance for the last ten years. The styles of the two German masters are so markedly different though both oratorios employ much of the contrapuntal devices. It is evident that the harmony Bach's counterpoint produces is a supreme example of religious music with contemplation and depths while Mendelssohn appeals to the emotional level through the varied rhythmic, tempo and dynamic impact.

PROGRAMME NOTES

The cantata Songs of Wisdom is written for junior and adult choirs. Professor Huang Chen-Mou is a prolific composer of Chinese sacred music. The cantata describes man's ignorance, man's searching for God and man's yearning for the Godgiven wisdom and knowledge.

Songs of Missions was written for the Canadian Bible College Choir where the composer David McIntyre and Innomine's conductor Dorothy Cheung were both teaching in the music department. The work was first performed at the school's Annual Missions Conference in 1977 with the two as the duo-piansts. As a fine pianist, McIntyre writes idiomatically featuring the nuances of the instrument and of duo-piano playing. The choral part is written in an e hergetic and rhythmic style with contemporary devices. "The Lord Reigneth" is based on I Chronicles calling for the people to rejoice because of the reign of the Lord. "The Church" brings out a driving urgency of Jesus' confirmation as stated in Matt. 16:18. The haunting ostinato bass adds to the structure an urge while the theme of Aurelia Chorale is introduced in an unusually calm and serene fashion. "Beneath the Cross of Jesus" is a simple yet appealing arrangement of the well known hymn. It calls for a commitment for the listener to take up the cross.

The next group of songs are all prayers written in the 19-20th centuries. Faure's beautiful treatment of melody and countermelody is heard in "Cantique de Jean Racine" as played by the warm tone of the French horn. Malotte's "The Lord's Prayer" is a favourite in any sacred concert and brings to the listener a worshipful experience. The next two are prayers in the form of a benediction, both written by the renowned English composer John Rutter. Rutter's writing is refreshing in style, simple and beautiful in harmonic texture, expressive in melodic lines; all these help to bring us closer to the Lord's presence.

The last three songs summarize the theme of the evening's programme. "I Am" clearly states whom the Lord said He Himself was. "Jesus is Still the Answer" is a simple gospel song bringing out the message of the faithfulness of the Lord. The concert closes with John Rutter's "For the Beauty of the Earth", a beautiful setting of Pierpoint's well known text. "To God our Lord we sing this joyful hymn of praise" is precisely the thought we want to leave with the audience in conclusion.

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
