欣樂詠團 主唱

上月在印尼椰加達參加了世界華人基督教聖樂促進會舉辦的大會和聖樂營,在這個來自世界各地近六百五十人參加之盛會中,每位參加者都如飢如渴地盡量努力學習各科有關聖樂的知識,並演唱大量傳統性的大型聖樂作品,眞是使人有「山上方五日,盡滌世間愁」之感。因為每一位學員都有專家和指揮家教導,故進步神速,同時在最後一天閉幕禮時更有十一隊詩班演唱大型聖樂作品,使人非常感動,但當我回到現實去時,却覺得演唱傳統性的大型聖樂作品的機會實在太少了。幸好欣樂詠團十六年以來,都在默默耕耘,努力工作,故能使更多人有機會欣賞傳統和大型的聖樂作品,這眞是令人高興啊!

回想一下,學習音樂也確是一件奢侈的事,為了一個演唱會、往往要練習數個月或一年半載、若要做好一個合唱伴奏,可能要練上五年甚至七年的鋼琴,有時還可能力不從心呢! 欣樂詠團的團友們在這十六年以來曾花費了多少時間,精神呢? 有時眞是沒法計算清楚!

在馬可福音十四章第三至七節裡,說到有一個女人拿一玉瓶至貴的眞哪達香膏來,打破玉瓶,把膏澆在耶穌的頭上,有幾個人心中很不悅說:何用這樣枉費香膏呢?這香膏可賣三十多兩銀子賙濟窮人,他們就向那女人生氣。耶穌說:「由他罷,為什麼難為他呢?他在我身上作的是一件『美事』」。的確這樣,我們有時也想過為什麼要費這麼多時間來練習呢?太不值得了。但當我們想到要把最好的奉獻給神時,又何必這樣吝嗇呢?主說,「你們在我身上作的是一件『美事』」,你作得的是甘心情願還是勉為其難呢?但願每一位神的兒女都能為神作一件「美事」,但願我們奉獻的時間和金錢都會蒙主喜悅呢!



欣樂詠團簡介圖

宗旨:

本詠團為非牟利之基督教團體,以音樂傳福音,主辦音樂會,提倡及促進教會音樂為曰標。

團名:

本詠團稱為「欣樂詠團」,在於表示基督徒在主裡滿有歡喜快樂之意。 拉丁文之「INNOM INE」即為「奉主名」之意,且其發音接近「欣樂」 ;故選用其音意之妙,以喻本團乃為一「奉主名」而成立之詠團也。

組織:

本詠團乃為政府註册不牟利團體,於一九七七年成立。設立董事局,董 事由會員大會產生。董事局又產生一行政小組,經常負責處理團內常務 ;又本詠團設有職員會,專門負責團務之維持及推廣。

經濟:

本詠團之一切經費除了蒙各界人仕捐贈,音樂會演出,銷售錄音帶等收入外,其餘部份由團員負責分擔。

演出紀錄:

十六年中,本詠團除了每年都有一次週年音樂會外,每年均有多次機會 到各教會、機構、醫院、學校等主領佈道會;並赴海外:台灣、星加坡 、馬來西亞、菲律賓、印尼、泰國、澳門及國內等地主領聖樂佈道會。

張美萍博士(指揮)

張博士少年時在港隨朱麗雲女士學習鋼琴,後移民美國在羅斯福大學隨名師 Saul Dorfman 繼續學琴。中學畢業後入北園大學主修音樂教育及鋼琴,副修管風琴及指揮,獲音樂教育學士。隨後考獲獎學金進入西北大學主修鋼琴,跟隨名師並室樂演奏家 Gui Mombaerts 習琴,Guy Duckworth (MENC 鋼琴科主席)學習鋼琴教授法,專門天才兒童、小組教授法。一年後獲得音樂碩士並同時被邀為Mu Phi Epsi Ion 及 Pi Kappa Lamda 兩美國榮譽音樂協會會員,繼而被邀留校鋼琴系初中組任教五年,期間在美國芝城教會擔任風琴師及詩班指揮十多年,又曾参加名指揮家 Robert Shaw 及 Margaret Hi IIis 主辦的合唱指揮研習班,鋼琴家 Victor Babin 的大師班。伴奏家 Gerald Moore 及聲樂家 Lotte Lehman 合辦的伴奏大師班。

深感神所賜音樂恩賜應專心從事聖樂工作。於是隨夫婿張慕皚博士往西南浸會神學院深造。選修了一年的聖樂博士課程。(跟隨 Robert Burton)習深造指揮法及選修管風琴。在院期間,兼任和聲學、樂理及鋼琴科助教,及專任聖樂院的聲樂科伴奏。隨後與夫婿往加拿大神學院事奉,任教聖樂科,同時繼續在教會詩班任指揮及其他事奉。

1980年,回港事奉,現任九龍城浸信會聖樂主任及指揮,建道神學院教會音樂科講師。曾在港九教會機構擔任聖樂講座,司琴、領詩、指揮及詩班等訓練班講師。現任香港聖樂學院董事、世界華人聖樂促進會香港區理事,自1984年為欣樂詠團指揮。

張博士於1990年在教會給予安息年時回到西南浸會神學院重新攻讀十九年前開始的聖樂博士課程,並於本年七月獲得音樂博士學位,主修聖樂及鋼琴演奏。



潘德小姐 (鋼琴)

潘德小姐早年跟隨葉李蕙荃女士及馮黎如冰女士學習鋼琴。在考獲LRSM鋼琴演奏文憑後前往英國倫敦皇家音樂學院深造,隨FREDERIC JACKSON及MAX PIRANI學習鋼琴,DOUGLAS HOPKINS學習管風琴。

在進修期間,除考獲 LRAM及 ARCM 鋼琴教授及演奏文憑外,更先後贏得皇家音樂學院頒贈之八項優勝獎。在皇家海外聯盟音樂節比賽中又榮獲決賽權。又曾於皇家聖樂學院進修,並考獲LTCL管風琴演奏文憑。 在英期間 曾多次公開演奏。

返港後亦曾多次在音樂會中獨奏及伴奏。現於香港演 藝學院及中文大學教授鋼琴,又為中華基督教會公理堂之 管風琴師。

潘德於一九八四年被選委任爲皇家音樂學院院士。



黃健瑜女士 (管風琴)

黃健瀚女士自幼隨陳朱麗雲女士學習鋼琴,後隨聶音琳博士學習風琴。先後考獲英國皇家音樂學院鋼琴教師及風琴演奏文憑。香港中文大學畢業後,七六年赴倫敦皇家音樂學院深造兩年,隨韓城治及柏特理教授學習風琴及鋼琴伴奏,獲學院之LRAM及ARCM演奏文憑,亦贏得基拿及李察士風琴演奏獎項。

黃健豫任循道衞理聯合教會九龍堂之風琴師多年,並 經常舉行風琴演奏會及擔任伴奏,曾為本港多個合唱團及 各教會之聯合詩班伴奏,現為香港聖樂團之伴奏。除演奏 外,亦熱心於教學工作,現任香港中文大學及香港演藝學 院風琴教師。



李建真先生 (男中音)

李建眞畢業於聖保羅男女中學及香港大學,曾與雅調合唱團演出"戰鼓彌撒曲"及與香港聖樂團演出"彌賽亞";現為香港雅樂社合唱團指揮,亦多次在盧景文製作之歌劇中擔任配角,或作合唱導師。李氏現隨男高音容可度研習聲樂。

歌曲介紹

今次音樂會歌曲包括由十七世紀至二十世紀的作品,有較為人熟悉的作曲家如韋發第 Vivaldi,布拉姆斯 Brahms,亦有少人知悉的如葛雷察尼諾夫 Gretchaninoff,麥戴維士 Mac Davis 等,歌曲由傳統曲式至現代節奏都有。

"In Memoria Aeterna"的歌詞簡單,旋律亦不複雜,前奏寧靜,各聲部依次以相同旋律進入,後半部份較為豐富,特色為一聲部之長音配合其他聲部緊密的節奏,表現出古典對位曲式優美的一面。"O Gladsome Light"作者為十九世紀後期俄國作曲家,充滿俄國民族色彩,對比十分強烈,包括最強聲與最弱聲,最高音與最低音,速度,聲部數目(四部至十部)等。"Let Nothing Ever Grieve Thee"介乎前二首之間,作者年代亦介乎兩曲作者之間,曲體接近傳統風格,音樂內容較為平靜,讓聽者可深入思索。整套曲目的調子偏慢,尤以第三首為甚。

第二組兩首歌曲為同一作者,一首為自創,一首為改編曲,調子輕快,節奏現代化。

第三組歌曲全為靈歌,較為自由化,節奏較慢,由混聲多聲部配合小組領唱。 "Steal Away"之合唱部份沈靜,主要為突出領唱者強而有力的旋律。 "Nobody Knows" 近似男女聲輪唱曲,由弱音開始,領唱者進入後將音調帶高,後由弱音結束。 "Deep River"與前首近似,但感覺較強,不同處為豐富的音量,衆多的切分節奏及附點節奏。

第四組歌曲為五首通神歌,着重表達人類身處神秘與感性的環境中,以靈與神直接交往的意境,前四首為獨唱曲配以不太重要的合唱;最後一首為合唱曲,由快速緊密的伴奏,加上整齊明快的合唱,好像人從冥想過後的高聲歌頌。

近代英國作曲家佛漢威廉士的一首頌歌 "O How Amiable" 開始,前段結構簡單,中段和聲效果增強,後段為雄壯的齊唱。 "Lord, Thou Hast Been Our Refuge" 為威廉士的一首經文曲,特色為整齊的和聲,多聲部合唱,多次轉調,配合小組領唱,但最後結束的段落作者以較為古典式的手法寫作,做成衝突性效果,把音樂會推上高潮。

德國作曲家韓德爾於1718至1720年間為Chandos公爵創作多套頌歌,此次選唱其第九號其中三首作為下半場首部份曲目,"O Praise The Lord"的特點為對位式與級進式並用,做成燦爛的效果,最後以整齊的合唱結束。"Ye Boundless Realms Of Joy"風格相似,"Your Voices Raise"主要為頓音及急速的音階,做成輝煌的效果。

第七組歌曲為熟悉的聖詩編曲,以中文演唱。

全場最後一首歌曲為麥戴維士的"Benediction",齊唱旋律與合唱和聲相間,前部平坦,中段激動,最後以平穩的阿們頌結束。
